To All Carriers:

In response to growing concerns over COVID-19, Liquid Freight would like to share some expectations and processes to make sure that we are all operating in the safest and most efficient manner possible to ensure that the health of your drivers, employees, families, customers and communities remains a priority.

Our expectations for any Carrier that is hauling Liquid Freight brokered loads are that:

- Any driver exhibiting symptoms or that has had exposure to COVID-19 is not permitted to transport loads brokered by Liquid Freight.
- Any employees who have symptoms of acute respiratory illness are recommended to stay home and not come to work until they are free of fever (100.4° F or greater using an oral thermometer), signs of fever, and any other symptoms for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing or other symptom-altering medicines (cough suppressants, etc.).
- Positive cases of COVID-19 will require a doctor's release before the employee may return to work.
- Carrier equipment is kept sanitized and clean to the best of your ability.
- All Carriers and Drivers will comply with all customer information requests regarding COVID-19
- All Carriers and Drivers will comply with all customer instructions at intake locations.

It is Liquid Freight's expectation that all carriers will abide by the above expectations as well as any FMCSA, Federal or State Government or CDC guidelines or mandates. Liquid Freight does not currently, nor will we ever, condone any actions that contradict any such governing bodies or organizations in the action of hauling a load brokered by Liquid Freight.
